RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe publishes a local newspaper, "The Fort Apache Scout", and

WHEREAS, the position of Newspaper Editor-in-Chief was vacated, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has received applications through its Personnel Office for this position, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Scout Committee has interviewed such applicants and recommends the selection of Mr. Max Evans for the position of Editor, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mr. Evans is capable of undertaking the responsibilities of Newspaper Editor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby employs Mr. Max Evans as Editor-in-Chief of the Fort Apache Scout at an annual pay rate of \$13,500.00, effective April 30, 1979.

The foregoing resolution was on June 06, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
