



RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to quality behavioral health and social services for its members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is built upon the strengths of its component family units, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that therapeutic intervention services to Apache Families at Risk will further strengthen the tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (PL 93-638) provides for the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to enter into contracts with tribes for said tribes to provide such services, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorized the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute such contracts and/or any amendments, and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Chairman is to run concurrent with the term of the contract, July 1, 1979 to September 30, 1979, and to remain in force for recontracting for Fiscal Year 1980.

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests from the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, a contract to provide services to Families At Risk, under Child Welfare Services funds. The contract, to begin July 1, 1979 through September 30, 1979, will request four staff positions and will be for a total amount of \$19,341.25 (\$77,365.00 per annum), for the first three-month period.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed contract be renewable for Fiscal Year 1980, and for an indefinite period of time thereafter, and that the authority granted under this resolution remain in force for recontracting purposes for Fiscal Year 1980.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the contract and/or any amendments and to sign any and all documents to consummate this contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the progress and content of the contract and/or amendments will be reviewed before the Tribal Council at ninety-day intervals for the life of the contract.

The foregoing resolution was on June 06, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
