## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has created the Apache Land Claims Youth Program from land claims funding, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires a Standing Committee be created with representatives from all reservation communities, for the purpose of community input directly to this program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council intends to create this committee with representatives who are directly interested and involved in the functions and purposes of a youth program, in order that this committee actively pursue the desires of each community that is represented.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby appoints to the Apache Land Claims Youth Recreation Program Committee the following representatives:

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the o-ficial title of this youth program shall be the Apache Land Claims Youth Recreation Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any prior resultions of the Tribal Council contrary to the provisions of this resolution are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
