

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has discussed the preapplication of the Administration for Native Americans Office to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under Public Law 93-638 for non-skilled services to twenty (20) elderly of the reservation, and

WHEREAS, it was the desire of the Tribal Council to support such an application from the Administration for Native Americans Office to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the purpose of contracting.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal for two (2) non-skilled care homes for twenty (20) elderly under Public Law 93-638.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this contractual agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
