

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs overlay Route 58, Sunrise Ski Lift Road from Arizona State Highway 273, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way, 100 feet in width and 2.503 miles in length, to overlay said roadway.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous right-of-way as recorded on a map on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
