RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that Mr. Lafe Altaha has been appointed to the Advisory Board of the National Education Committee for the Handicapped, and
- WHEREAS, the Council finds this is a great honor for both Mr. Altaha and the tribe for his representation, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Altaha is expected to appear for the Swear-In-Ceremonies on July 10 thru 11, 1979, all expenses paid, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Altaha has requested and would enjoy bringing his wife, Rebecca, to this ceremony in his honor, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to financially assist in the cost of the trip for Mrs. Rebecca Altaha.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the payment of air fare of roundtrip to Washington, D.C. and per diem sufficient to cover this trip for Mrs. Rebecca Altaha.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for this expenditure shall come from the Public Relations Account BudgetiFiscal Year 1979-80.

The foregoing resolution was on June 20, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
