RESOLUTION OF THE ... WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is committed to providing adequate housing opportunities to all tribal members within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is particularly concerned that such opportunities are made available to tribal members who are in great need of housing and other assistance, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered the priority needs of Lillian and Charles Truax for housing, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is appropriate for these tribal members to be added to a Number One priority list under the Home Improvement Program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe currently has a contract for such priority housing through the Phoenix Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs which it desires to amend in order to provide the necessary housing opportunity to the Truaxes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman to take all actions necessary to amend the current contract under the Home Improvement Program in order to include Lillian and Charles Truax on the Number One priority list for housing in such program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby request the Contracting Officer in the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to make every effort possible to include these needy tribal members in the Home Improvement Program in the priority list for immediate housing.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
