


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware of the critical need for an emergency domestic water supply to the residents of the community of Rainbow City, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned for the health and survival of these community residents if emergency assistance is not provided immediately, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires the input of assistance of the Indian Health Service in responding to this emergency need for water supply.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman to take all such actions as are necessary and appropriate to remedy the emergency water supply shortage now existing in the community of Rainbow City.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council requests the Indian Health Service to assist the Tribal Chairman in meeting these emergency needs.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
