

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 79-137 amending the budget of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Tribal Herd was passed by the Tribal Council on July 10, 1979; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Manager that the Capital Expenditure of \$12,000 budgeted therein for purchase of a new trailer could be spent more advantageous for purchasing a new vehicle in the amount of \$7,248.62, with the remainder to be utilized on the existing bunk house; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is badly needed since the one currently utilized is completely undependable and worn out.

BE IT RESOLVED by the poll whose signatures are affixed amend Resolution 79-137 to change the purpose of the \$12,000 budgeted therein.

The foregoing resolution was on July 17, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of Six for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
