RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised of the termination of Jacqueline Hinton from employment at Hondah Service Station, an operation of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mrs. Hinton's employment and service record does not warrant her termination from tribal employment, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that Mrs. Hinton's reinstatement in the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, at the Hon-dah Service Station, is just and proper.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Enterprise to immediately reinstate Mrs. Jacqueline Hinton at her previous employment at the Hondah Service Station.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 7, 1979</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine for, zero against and one abstention</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
