

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has discussed the Request for Proposal for the FY 1979 Multipurpose Senior Center Program, Title III-B Monies for Multipurpose Senior Center Acquisition, Alteration, or Renovation under Sections 501-505 of Title V of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended by Public Law 95-478 cited as the "Comprehensive Older Americans Act Amendments of 1978", and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to submit an application under the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended by the Comprehensive Older Americans Act Amendments of 1978 for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Elderly.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal before the August 17, 1979 deadline for Multipurpose Senior Center Acquisition, Alteration or Renovation under Sections 501-505 of Title V of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended by the Comprehensive Older American Act Amendment of 1978.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


