

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted Resolution No. 79-126 on June 12, 1979, to provide for the immediate enforcement of Ordinances 31 and 99 relating to livestock and grazing within the reservation; and

WHEREAS, it was the intention of the Tribal Council in passing said resolution to mandate such enforcement be undertaken by the General Manager of the General Livestock Association.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 79-126 to specifically direct the immediate enforcement of Ordinance 31 and Ordinance 99 by the General Manager of the General Livestock Association.


