RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with proposed 1979/80 regulations on Non-Tribal Members Hunting and Fishing within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered such regulations, and copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it necessary and appropriate to specifically document in such regulations that no tribal permits are transferable or assignable, and that only one elk kill per hunter is permitted under any circumstances during the Tribal Trophy Elk Hunt.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the 1979/80 regulations for Non-Tribal Members Hunting and Fishing within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, as attached hereto, and subject to the specific additions to such regulations as are hereinabove referenced.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984).
