RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with a proposed Boat Registration requirement within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation by the Board of Directors of White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise, through its General Manager; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is in the best interests of the Tribe and the Enterprise that any boats used by Non-Tribal Members on any waters within the Reservation be registered by the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council accepts the recommendation of the General Manager of the Enterprise to establish a ten dollar (\$10.00) per year registration fee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the White
 Mountain Recreation Enterprise to require the registration
 of all boats used by non-tribal members within the Fort
 Apache Indian Reservation, on any waters within the
 reservation, and to charge a ten dollar per year registration fee, to be effective January 1, 1980.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that violations by non-tribal members of this regulation shall be deemed a violation of tribal law, in accordance with existing procedures established through the Board of Directors of the Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984).
