RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Ataloha (Kessay) Fellers, a tribal members, holds a lease on the premises commonly known as, "The Bean Pot", and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Fellers has requested the authorization from the Tribal Council to sublease a portion of her lease interest to a non-Indian, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered her request, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has advised her that such action will require a rental charge by the Tribe for her lease, and
- WHEREAS, rental assessments of tribal property are based on appropriate appraisals done by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Mrs. Ataloha (Kessay) Fellers, a tribal member, to sublease to a non-Indian the premises commonly known as, "The Bean Pot".
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby requests that a Bureau of Indian Affairs appraisal be made of Mrs. Feller's leasehold interest with the purpose of determining a rental charge payable by her to the Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
