FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented a list of tribal members requesting specific farmland assignments, and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the farmland applications as recommended by the Land Committee.


