RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has previously enacted Resolution Nos. 79-126 and 79-161 demanding the immediate enforcement of Ordinances No. 31 and 99, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and informed that such enforcement is not being carried out as directed by the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council continues to require that Mr. Paul Amos, Jr., General Livestock Manager, fully comply with the directives of the Tribal Council in enforcing tribal livestock ordinances.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby further directs Mr. Paul Amos, Jr., General Livestock Manager, to comply with Tribal Council Resolutions No. 79-126 and 79-161 to enforce Ordinances 31 and 99 immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby directed to notify Mr. Paul Amos, Jr. of the policy and position of the Tribal Council herein set forth.

The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
