RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized under the Indian Reorganization Act, 25 U.S.C 476, with a duly approved Constitution and By-Laws, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe exercises powers of self-government; including police powers, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe exercises police powers in the operations of its law enforcement agency, the Whiteriver Police Department, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and aware that the Tribal Police Department is pursuing an extensive police training program for all tribal police officers at the White Mountain Apache Police Training Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council strongly encourages full and complete training of its police officers, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Police Training Officer has presented to the Tribal Council, for its review and approval, a detailed outline of a 426-hour Tribal Law Enforcement Course currently in progress within the Tribal Police Training Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interests of the Tribe and its police department that such Tribal Police Training Program be certified by the Arizona Law Enforcement Officer Advisory Council, in order that the high training standards established through the Tribal Police Training Center may be recognized and maintained.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the White Mountain Apache Police Training Center and Program hereinabove referenced.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council requests that such Police Training Center be certified by the Arizona Law Enforcement Officer Advisory Council for the purposes set forth herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Police Training Officer is directed and authorized to take all such action as is necessary and appropriate to carry out the purposes of this resolution.
- The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
