RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware of the fact that the business activities of the Tribe are increasing daily, and
- WHEREAS, these increased activities require special facility demands not economically available through the Tribe's present computor system, and
- WHEREAS, in order to meet the need and demands, the tribe is requesting that they be provided with better standards for the best interests and benefit of the tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves the purchase of a computor suited to meet these needed demands.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for the purchase of this computor, in the amount of \$85,047.00 be obtained from Public Law 93-638, Tribal Government Improvement funds.

The foregoing resolution was on November 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
