

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an Annual Tribal Fair and Rodeo,
and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe grants individual tribal members
the right to construct concession booths for the sale of goods during
the time of the Fair, at or near the present Fair Grounds, and

WHEREAS, these concession booths however are standing throughout the year and
constitute an unsafe and dangerous fire trap to the residents of the
immediate area.


BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council directs the
individual owners of these concession booths to dismantle and/or
otherwise dispose of the materials and remove them from tribal land
at or near the Tribal Fair Grounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Safety Director is hereby authorized
and directed to advise such individual owners of this Council directive
and to act for and on behalf of the Tribe in obtaining their compliance
herewith.

The foregoing resolution was on November 08, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of
7 for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the
Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27,
1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
