RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has discussed the rules on the Food Stamp and Food Distribution Programs which were finalized in the June 19, 1979 Federal Register, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to submit an application to the United States Department of Agriculature, Food and Nutrition Services, for administration of a Food Distribution Program in concurrent operation with the present Food Stamp Program on a Reservation-wide basis.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Services for a Food Distribution Program to be operated concurrently with the Food Stamp Program on a Reservation-wide basis.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consumate this grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 195i, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
