RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the weighing scale at the Airport Sale Pen of the General Livestock Association is in need of repairs or replacement, and
- WHEREAS, the Ceneral Livestock Association has requested a \$4,000.00 grant from the Tribe to repair this scale, and
- WHFRFAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed this request and has considered the nature of private ownership of the General Livestock Association as well as the benefits to tribal member cattle owners from the operation of the weigh scale during cattle sales.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes the appropriation of \$4,000.00 by an amendment to the Central Tribal Budget, Fiscal Year 79-80 and the expenditure of \$2,000.00 of such amount as a grant to the Ceneral Livestock Association and the loan of an additional \$2,000.00 to the Association, to be paid back upon such terms and conditions as shall be established by the Business Office, for the purpose of repairing the weighing scale at the Airport Sale Pen.

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against and 1 abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
