

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to grant authorization to Mr. David Neally to conduct a geological mapping survey of the White Mountain Apache Reservation for his Master's Degree thesis from Northern Arizona University, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the possible utility to the Tribe of such study, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the necessary discretion required of such a survey.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Mr. David Neally to conduct a geological mapping survey of the White Mountain Apache Reservation for his Master's Degree thesis from Northern Arizona University.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that Mr. Neally provide a copy to the Tribal Chairman of all findings, maps, or other results of such survey; report regularly to the Tribal Chairman, and abide by any other directions of the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


