RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe regulates the sale or offering for sale of articles or services by peddlers within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation pursuant to Ordinance No. 109, enacted on September 13, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and discussed the feasibility of having the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission issue peddler's permits to otherwise enforce the provisions of Ordinance No. 109 for and on behalf of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the use of income from the sale of peddler's permits, by the Commission, as of December 1, 1979 for the purpose of providing funds for the new Fair and Rodeo Complex until such complex is completed, and thereafter, for the purpose of offsetting the operating costs of the Tribal Fair and Rodeo, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to increase the fee charged for peddler's permits from \$5.00 for the first date issued to \$25.00 for the first day issued, effective December 1, 1979.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission to issue peddler's permits and to otherwise enforce the provisions of Ordinance No. 109 for and on behalf of the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that the fee charged for peddler's permits be and hereby is increased from \$5.00 to \$25.00 for the first day issued, effective December 1, 1979.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes the deposit of income from the sale of peddler's permits to the account of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission, and the use thereof for funding the new Fair and Rodeo Complex, until such complex is completed, and thereafter, for the purpose of offsetting the operating costs of the Tribal Fair and Rodeo.

The foregoing resolution was on December 12, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
