RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that the Arizona Department of Economic Security, the Comprehensive Employment Training Act, Title 11B prime sponsor, will allocate Fiscal Year 1980 Comprehensive Employment Training Act, Title 11B funds in the amount of \$192,424.00 to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Comprehensive Employment Training Act sub-grantee, which will enable the Tribe to plan and administer a Comprehensive Employment Training Act, Title 11B Work Experience and On-the-Job Training Program, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has, as one of its priority needs, the proper development of tribal members to their fullest potential through actual classrom, work experience, and on-the-job training programs which will motivate the tribal members to continue their education; and said federal job funding will enable the Tribe to enroll into the program, young CETA eligible participants attending the following schools:

Phoenix Indian School Sherman Indian School Stewart Indian School Inter-Mountain Inter-Tribal Indian School and local area schools

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the submittal of a grant proposal under the subject Fiscal Year 1980 CETA Title 11B Program, (and in all subsequent Title 11B allocations) with the objective of providing the maximum possible number of work experience enrollee positions and on-the-job training positions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents necessary in order to carry out this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 02, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
