

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is considering a proposal to pool all trust funds held in the United States Treasury for and on behalf of Indian Tribes across the country, for the purpose of more unified investment of such funds while held by the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered such proposal regarding the inclusion of funds of the White Mountain Apache Tribe held in trust, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that such pooling of funds will not be of significant or direct benefit to the Tribe since tribal funds held in trust currently yield the highest interest allowable due to the magnitude of such amounts, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that it is not in the best interests of the Tribe to have its trust funds further tied up in investments and bookkeeping with trust funds of other Tribes.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal funds held in trust in the United States Treasury for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe shall not be pooled or commingled with the trust funds of any other Tribe, for the purpose of investment or other purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to take such action as is necessary to notify the Bureau of Indian Affairs of the Tribe's directive herein.

The foregoing resolution was on January 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
