

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to provide assistance to the Elderly Program in obtaining a vehicle for use in the Program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Elderly Program has funding available to pay rental on such vehicle, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that a new vehicle is badly needed for the purposes of this program.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby [authorizes the purchase of a new vehicle, in the name of the Tribe, to be leased to the Elderly Program.]

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the Central Tribe Business Office to provide for appropriate funding for said purchase to obtain such vehicle at the lowest bid, and to arrange for rental payments, and other appropriate terms and conditions, with the Elderly Program for the purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
