RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Central Tribe charges the various Enterprises on apportioned amount for Central Office Administrative services, and

WHEREAS, these charges have not been readjusted annually, and

WHEREAS, the increase of costs to the Central Tribe must be passed onto the Enterprises, in order to continue these services.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe sets the rates for Central Office Administrative expenses for Fiscal Year 1980/81, as follows:

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & K) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
