

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with information, through the Indian Health Service and Tribal Health Authority, on problems and studies dealing with respiratory infections in infants, and

WHEREAS, such presentation made by Dr. Dave Bell, a pediatrician with the Center for Disease Control, would indicate that such respiratory infections are significantly higher among tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation than among other groups of people, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that a one week study of these matters by Dr. Bell and the Indian Health Service would provide information to the White Mountain Apache mothers for the prevention of such respiratory infections, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that such one week study would also provide critical medical information to benefit national efforts to control infant respiratory diseases, while providing safeguards to White Mountain Apache infants.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a one week study, to be conducted by the Center for Disease Control and Indian Health Service personnel, on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, for the purpose of obtaining information on infant respiratory diseases, which information can be utilized to prevent such diseases in White Mountain Apaches.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs in this regard that all measures be taken to safeguard the health and welfare of tribal members involved by such study by the Indian Health Service and all persons acting at its direction or in its behalf.


The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
