

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to provide donated assistance to the Whiteriver Police Department training program in the form of lumber materials, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered this request and approves its purposes on behalf of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs its Fort Apache Timber Company to donate to the Whiteriver Police Department, lumber in such sizes as shall be designated by the Chief of Police, up to the total value of \$200.00 for the purpose hereinabove described.

The foregoing resolution was on March 05, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
