

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has faced the compelling truth that the costs of travel on tribal business has greatly risen during the last fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered recommendations to adjust the travel per diem and mileage rates for council members in order to bring them more into line with such travel cost increases, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also finds it necessary and proper to amend the per diem for attendance at Tribal Council meetings in order to better match the ever growing demands on the tribal governing body.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes the travel per diem rate for Council members travelling on tribal business, at \$100.00 per day, for such business travel outside of the State of Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council establishes the travel mileage rate for council members travelling on tribal business at eighteen cents (18¢) per mile, for such business travel using a private vehicle.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council establishes the per die attendance fee rate for Tribal Council meetings at \$75.00 per day.


The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
