WHEREAS, this program has been well accepted by the Tribe and appreciated by those tribal members receiving its services, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to continue this program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe's Central Business Office proceed in obtaining a Home Improvement Grant for Fiscal Year 1980 and Fiscal Year 1981.


