

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Bureau of Indian Affairs currently operates the Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School at Fort Apache on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Public Law 95-561 directs the establishment of local school boards for such Bureau of Indian Affairs schools in order to provide for local input into the operation of such schools, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further acknowledges the ongoing complaints and problems between non-tribal member students from the school, and the community and law enforcement people on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously acted to request the Bureau's assistance in transferring Theodore Roosevelt School to tribal jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council therefore finds, for all the above reasons, that it is in the best interests of the tribe to establish a permanent local school board with authority and responsibility over the Theodore Roosevelt School at Fort Apache.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the establishment of a permanent school board for the Theodore Roosevelt School at Fort Apache, to be composed of the current membership of the Indian Education Committee, Phillip Stago, Jr. and Reno Johnson, Sr., for the purposes hereinabove set forth.


The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
