

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that tribal members, Eva Kasey, Loretta Altaha and Dena Lupe have been abruptly terminated from employment under ANA feeding program cooks, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further informed that federal funding to said program did not meet time projections on its expiration, and

WHEREAS, such lack of funding now causes economic hardship to these unemployed tribal members through no fault of their own, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there may be two positions currently available at the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise, in the Tribal Restaurant, for which two of these tribal members might qualify and are interested.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal members Eva Kasey, Loretta Altaha and Dena Lupe be given priority in hiring by the Tribe, for positions comparable to those which were terminated as herein described, on the basis of the nature of such termination, the need for continued support to their families and their respective qualifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Dena Lupe and Loretta Altaha be hired immediately in the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise in two positions at the Restaurant, if available, and for which they are qualified and interested.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


