

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe provides for the selection of an Associate Judge of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in accordance with Ordinance No. 112, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered appropriate nominees to fill the position of the Associate Judge position upon the expiration of the current term of Associate Judge on May 5, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the reappointment of Mr. George Garland who has filled said position for the past four-year terms.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Mr. George Garland as the Associate Judge of the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a four-year term, beginning May 5, 1980.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary and other terms of such employment shall be established through the Tribal Personnel Department.


The foregoing resolution was on April 9, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
