WHEREAS, regular 1980 Tribal Election has been completed, and


WHEREAS, the Election abstract listing the winners has been read to the Tribal Council and

WHEREAS, there was no 1% margin for a mandatory recount in any of the four districts.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the results from the 1980 Election be accepted and the new councilmen for the next four (4) years will be as follows:

District I	Adam Lupe, Sr.	277 votes
District II	Raymus Albert	286 votes
District III	Alvino Hawkins	316 votes
District IV	West Anderson, Sr.	389 votes

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
