WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware of the significant and successful efforts of the Sixth Grade class of the Whiteriver Elementary School to raise monies for a class trip to San Diego, California, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to provide a \$1500.00 donation to assist in payment of the expenses for such trip, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council acknowledges the efforts of its young tribal members in making sincere efforts to primarily provide for their own class projects.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a \$1500.00 donation by the Tribe to the Sixth Grade Class of the Whiteriver Elementary School for the purposes hereinabove specified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds shall be paid from Central Tribal Contingency Funds, Fiscal Year 79-80 Budget.


The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
