

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is in need of quality Health Care Services to be rendered by Indian Health Services, and
- WHEREAS, through this justifiable intention, in 1968 the White Mountain Apache Tribe initially became involved in important functions of the Phoenix Area Indian Health Board, Inc., and
- WHEREAS, the continual surveillance by a tribal representative of Indian Health Service appropriated funds, at the Congressional and Area levels is essential, and
- WHEREAS, the continual communication links between the respective tribe, through such tribal representative, the Phoenix Unit, the Phoenix Indian Health Service Area Office and the Washington Indian Health Service Headquarters, are of great importance, and
- WHEREAS, currently, the incumbent, Chairman of the Phoenix Area Indian Health Board, Inc., which encompasses ten Service Units in the following states of Arizona, Nevada, Utah and California, is Mr. Billy Kane, an enrolled White Mountain Apache.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe formally endorses Mr. Billy A. Kane, an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, as the tribe's representative to the Phoenix Area Indian Health Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports the efforts of the Board to its work with all Tribes to help provide the best possible Health Care to Indian people.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe charges its designated representative and the Board with said responsibility.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
