


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council previously enacted Resolution No. 77-227 on November 2, 1977 for the purpose of authorizing and directing the establishment of the position of Tribal Prosecutor, and
- WHEREAS, by the terms of said resolution, the Tribal Attorney was directed to recommend an individual with proper qualifications to fill such position, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the continuing and expanding need for the position of Tribal Prosecutor, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further considered the desirability of utilizing the services of an attorney and a local resident to better serve the needs of the tribe in such position, and
- WHEREAS, the position of Tribal Prosecutor is currently vacant and the Tribal Attorney has recommended the filling of such vacancy with Mr. Joseph J. Hessinger, an attorney who resides in Lakeside, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Hessinger is a qualified and practices law with the Tribal Attorney in Pinetop, Arizona, and has provided the Tribal Council with a copy of his personal resume.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the employment of Joseph J. Hessinger as Tribal Prosecutor within the current budget limitations and in accordance with Tribal Personnel Manual.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for, 4 abstentions and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
