WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council in previous years has received assistance from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Home Improvement, and


WHEREAS, this program has been well accepted by the Tribe and appreciated by those tribal members receiving its services, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to continue this program, and


WHEREAS, this program is to start May 1, 1989 and ending September 30, 1980.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman proceed in obtaining a Home Improvement Contract for Fiscal Year 1980.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
