FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed of proposed rules on traders licenses, 25 CFR Part. 251, published in the Federal Register on April 25, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and discussed the contents of said proposed rules, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the effect of such rules, if passed, would be adverse to the interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman to state the position of the Tribal Council as discussed on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, as required by the "Notice of proposed rulemaking", and as is otherwise appropriate in order to carry out the intent of the Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
