


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it is the constant desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to improve the housing situation for tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to enter into a long-term lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority in HUD Project No. Arizona 16-30 (100 Mutual-Help) to serve this purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are authorized and directed to enter into a lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for those areas covered under HUD Project No. Arizona 16-30 (100 Mutual-Help).

The foregoing resolution was on June 04, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
