WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is continually concerned for providing adequate housing to all tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by two such tribal members, Mrs. Rachel Ethelbah and Ms. Ethelyne Kessay for assistance from the Tribal Council in their respective housing programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Ms. Kessay is in extreme need of a house to provide for herself and minor brothers and sisters, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mrs. Rachel Ethelbah is in dire need of repairs and renovation to her home in order to bring it up to livable standards.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs top priority be given to the construction of a home under the Home Improvement Program to Ms. Ethelyne Kessay.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Rachel Ethelbah be given assistance by the Save the Children Federation Program in repairing and renovating her home as is necessary and proper.


