

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has previously discussed the Community Food and Nutrition Program (CFNP) and has submitted a preapplication to Region IX to use this program to promote access for low-income people to federal and non-federal food and nutrition programs to provide nutrition and consumer education, and to provide crisis relief, and

WHEREAS, the deadline for submitting Community Food and Nutrition Program proposals has been set at July 7, 1980.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal for the Community Food and Nutrition Program, and is authorized to sign any and all documents required to consummate the grant application and to recontract each and every year thereafter.


The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
