

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by the East Fork Community for consideration in financial assistance for the renovation of the community building, for the benefit of the East Fork people, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has repeatedly considered that the purpose of Revenue Sharing Funds is to benefit the various communities on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, the East Fork Community Representatives requested the council that they be considered for up to \$16,000.00 of such funds to complete the necessary renovation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the expenditure of up to \$16,000.00 from Revenue Sharing Funds for the purposes of renovating the East Fork Community Building as proposed by such community.


The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
