

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the I.D. Herd Enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the position of General Manager of the Enterprise is vacant; and

WHEREAS, this position has been advertised and applications have been taken and reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the qualifications of Mr. Daniel J. Troncale for such position; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds Mr. Troncale qualified, on a probationary basis, pending a background criminal and financial investigation in order to protect the interest of the Tribe and the performance of the ID Herd Manager duties;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the employment of Mr. Troncale as General Manager of the ID Herd Enterprise, in accordance with all applicable provisions of the Tribal Personnel Manual;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said employment shall be on a probationary basis and subject to a background criminal and financial investigation of said employee by the Whiteriver Police Department and the Central Tribe Business Office, respectively for the purposes hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the ID Herd Enterprise obtains the presence of Mr. Troncale at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting, if such employee accepts this position.


The foregoing resolution was on June 20, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
