

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise is conducted with a Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs that the 1980-81 budget for the Enterprise has not yet been approved because of necessary changes in the total budget figures.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Board of Directors of the Whiteriver Commercial Center to make any and all corrections in its FY 80-81 Budget, necessary for Bureau of Indian Affairs approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is directed to advise the Board of Directors of the contents and purposes of this resolution.


