

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by the Canyon Day Community for a donation of lumber to use and repairing and improving the Community rodeo grounds; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that two bundles of 2x6 lumber is needed for this purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes the donation of the above described lumber from the Tribe's Fort Apache Timber Company.


The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
