

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has requested to designate certain land west of the Baptist Church in Whiteriver for the purpose of constructing a public baseball field; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered this request and finds that such public recreational use is in the best interest of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of land west of the Baptist Church in Whiteriver for the construction of a public baseball field.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Land Board is hereby requested to designate and record the specific area for the use herein authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bay-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


