

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that Resolution No. 80-185 and 80-186 enacted by the Tribal Council on June 20, 1980, were not delivered to the Bureau of Indian Affairs within ten days of their enactment; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to remove any doubt over the validity of such resolutions in the event that the ten-day time limit is applicable.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 80-185 and 80-186 enacted on June 20, 1980.


The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
